- Approval of Meeting Minutes August/September Call to order by Jen at 6:33
- President's Report: Kristi/Jen (10 minutes) Sara motions to approve kristi seconds
- Movie Night recap great turnout, layout shift to fit food trucks was great and we are hoping to keep that for the next
- o Playground presentation and outreach to board kristi shares slides that she is presenting to the board. We have estimates and are looking for the district/school board for support in managing. We suggested we wait until after the election to meet and discuss. The president suggested we prepare a packet of information for me which Kristi did, she's sending out to them tonight. We're looking for clear timelines and a way forward to improve our school site.
- Financials: Sara/Alyssa (10 minutes) 52,9 for voluntary tuition total, missing our goal of \$, fourth graders won the cupcake party with 79% of students participation. Budget \$1,500 and cost us \$3,390, and we made \$2507 in sales and donations.
- o Scholastic Book Fair revenue is about \$5,000. Deciding tonight whether to take the cash out option vs the scholastic dollars that we can use with them as essentially a credit. For every dollar we sold we would get 50 cents in scholastic dollars. The cash out option percentage isn't known at this time, but is less than the other option. Previous PTO boards opted for scholastic dollars. Kristi motions to take the scholastic dollars and claire seconds.

- Fall Festival we surpassed our goal of 5k and we raised 10,100 in sponsor donations. Booth and sponsor donations have covered the rides and rentals. Goal of \$15,000 for the entire festival.
